

Irrigation

Sedgwick County Electric has 3 different rate schedules for our Irrigation Member's, which are:

- **Horsepower Charge** – For single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage. Members would have a charge of \$20.00 per connected horsepower plus an Energy Charge of \$9.7994¢ per kWh and applicable Energy Cost Adjustment (ECA).
- **Load Control for Irrigation Services** – If the Member agrees to participate in the Cooperative's load control program and agrees to the installation of a load control equipment on the Members irrigation equipment, the Member will receive a credit of \$20.00 per connected and controlled horsepower per service year. Energy Charge is \$9.7994¢ per kWh plus applicable ECA. The load control equipment will be installed and maintained by the Cooperative. The member must pay ½ of the cost of the equipment and installation (\$1,050 if signed up by January 20, 2014). The load control device may curtail service for up to five hours per day on days when the temperature is at or above 95 degrees Fahrenheit.
- **Time of Day** – Currently for single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage. With this rate the irrigator would decide when to run their irrigation. The monthly rate would be \$9.00 per month plus applicable ECA and an Energy Charge of 30 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) during the on peak period, or 8.8 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for all kWh during the off peak period. The on-peak period is defined as 3:00pm to 8:00pm daily between June 1st and September 30th inclusive. All other hours are off-peak.
