IRRIGATION**APPLICABILITY :**

Applicable to consumers contracting for use of electric power for irrigation pumping service on an annual basis.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

RATE:

Horsepower Charge:	\$20.00 per connected horsepower
Plus	
Energy Charge:	9.7994¢ per kWh for all kWh

ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

Reference Index No.1 and 2.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE:

The minimum annual charge shall be the highest of the following charges.

1. The Horsepower Charge. (5 hp minimum)
2. In accordance with the Line Extension Policy; or
3. As determined in the service contract.

IRRIGATION (cont.)**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

Bills will be rendered monthly for usage in the months of May through September with one fifth of the horsepower charge being billed each month plus applicable energy charges.

Within the 12th month of each service year, the Cooperative will read the meter and calculate the amount due for the remainder of the service year in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Payment of any amount due on a bill shall be in accordance with the Cooperative's rules and regulations.

Service year shall be from April 25 to April 25 of the following year.

LOAD CONTROL RIDER FOR IRRIGATION SERVICES

(EXPERIMENTAL)

APPLICABILITY :

This rider is applicable to service currently being served under Rate Schedule IR-09.

LOAD CONTROL CREDIT:

If the Consumer agrees to participate in the Cooperative's load control program and agrees to the installation of a load control device (s) on the Consumer's irrigation equipment, the Consumer will receive a credit of \$20.00 per connected and controlled horsepower per service year. The load control device (s) will be installed and maintained by the Cooperative. The load control device (s) may curtail service for up to five hours per day on days when the temperature is at or above 95 degrees Fahrenheit.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. A consumer receiving a credit under this tariff would forfeit the credit if he terminates the program anytime during June, July, August or September of the service year.
2. The consumer shall reimburse the Cooperative for 50% of the cost of the load control devices and the cost of installation. All devices shall remain the property of the Cooperative.
3. The minimum annual charge under this program will be \$75.00.
4. The Cooperative has the right to limit the participation in this program, as it is experimental in nature.

TIME OF DAY IRRIGATION SERVICE RATE EXPERIMENTAL

APPLICABILITY :

Applicable to consumers contracting for use of electric power for irrigation pumping service on an annual basis.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customer Charge - \$9.00 per month

plus

Energy Charge - 30¢ per kilowatt-hour (kWh)
For all kWh during the on peak period, plus
8.8¢ per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for all kWh during
the off-peak period.

TIME OF DAY BILLING PERIODS:

During the summer billing season (usage between June 1st and September 30th inclusive), the on-peak period is defined as 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily. All other hours are off-peak. It is the sole responsibility of the Customer to shed loads, either manually or automatically, to reduce consumption during the on-peak periods. The Cooperative will not be required to notify the Customer of the beginning or end of on-peak periods or seasons.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The consumer shall reimburse the Cooperative for 50% of the cost of the Time of Day meter and the cost of installation. All meters shall remain the property of the Cooperative.
2. Any termination of this program during June, July, August or September of any service year would require the consumer's entire usage to be recalculated under the standard irrigation rate including the horsepower charge.
3. Service hereunder is subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative.
4. The Cooperative has the right to limit the participation in this program, as it is experimental in nature.
